



## ASAPS FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The ASAPS Fellowship program has been developed to expand on the pre Fellowship training in aesthetic surgery that is an integral part of Plastic and Reconstructive surgery training. This allows subspecialisation in an area of interest such as breast surgery, facial surgery, rhinoplasty surgery, body contouring surgery.

At the end of the College training we would like to offer our graduates the option to learn and compliment their aesthetic knowledge and skills by doing a fellowship.
