The biennial Craniomaxillofacial surgery course (CMF) will be held 3 – 5 October 2019 at the Hilton Hotel Queenstown (Double Tree) New Zealand. 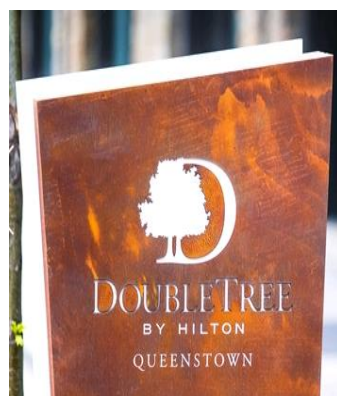

UPDATE as at 30th July

The month of October in Queenstown is a busy time, coinciding with local and Australian school holidays. We have been notified by Hilton (both Resort & Spa and Doubletree) that accommodation at the conference venue is **booked out on Wednesday 2 October**.
