

Fellow Position, Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery – Flinders Medical Centre,

South Australia

We are seeking applicants for a 12 month position at Flinders Medical Centre in Adelaide for a Fellow in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery commencing August 2020. The position is not sub-specialty specific but gives exposure to a wide range of elective and emergency plastic surgery activity including breast reconstruction, hands, paediatric, facial fractures, abdominoplasty and breast reduction, free flap reconstructions and head and neck cancer. Flinders Medical Centre is a University Teaching Hospital and the unit consists of 9 consultants, 4 registrars and 5 junior doctors.

Flinders Medical Centre (FMC) is the southern area's largest hospital providing medical services for the southern population of Adelaide and major regional rural centres. The campus is situated in the Adelaide foothills on an 11.5 hectare campus approximately 12 kilometres from the city centre and only a few kilometres from the beautiful South coast beaches.
