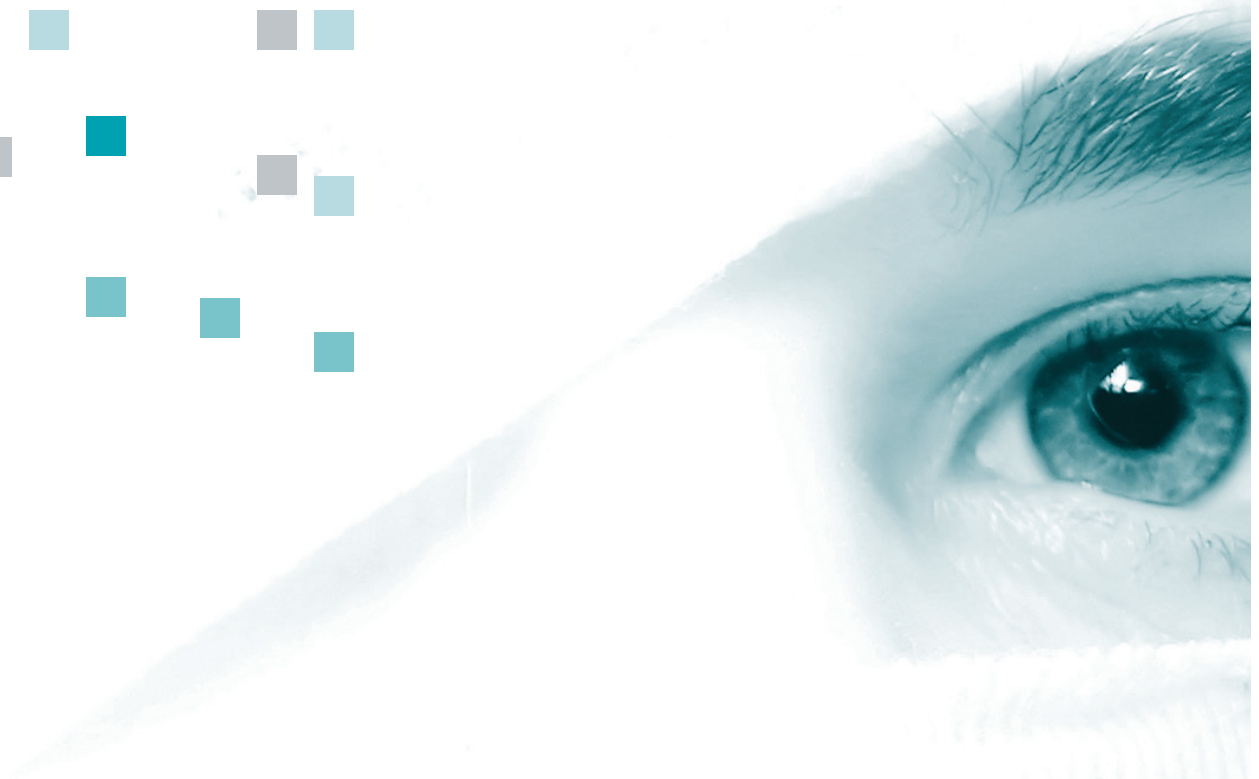

## Awards

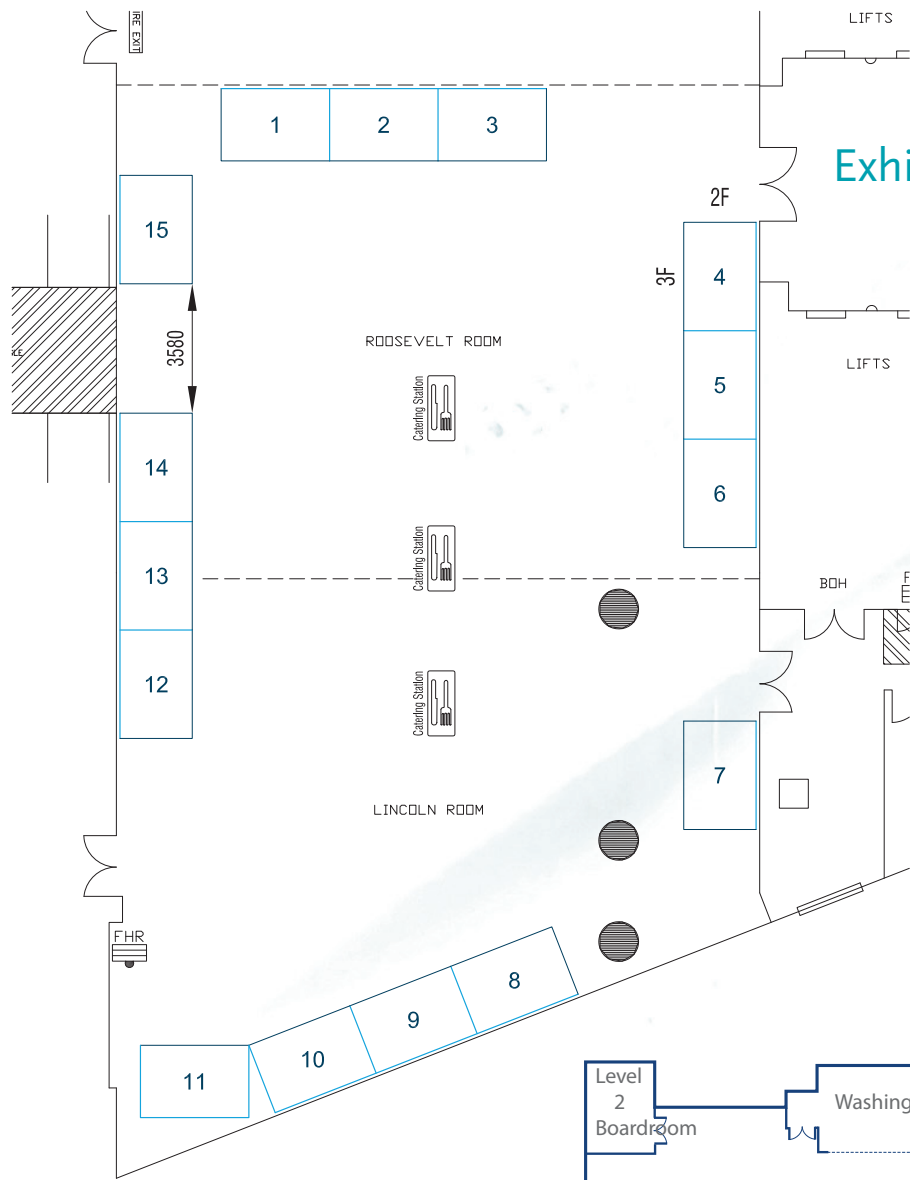

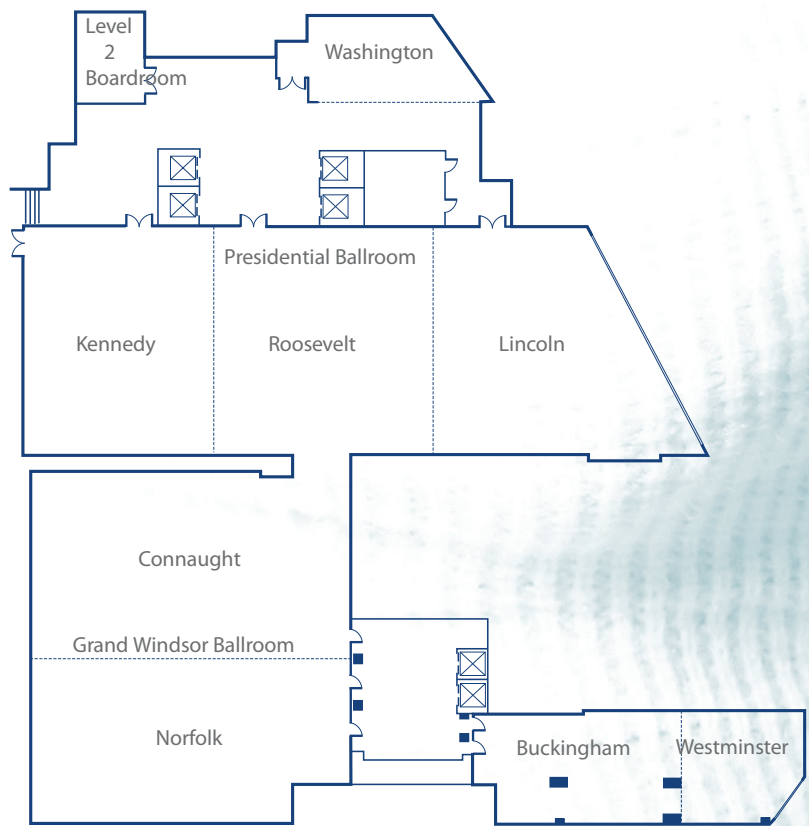
