Guy Dowling, Melbourne-based Plastic Surgeon, obtained his Bachelor of Science First Class Honours from the University of Melbourne in 1987, and his Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery from Flinders University in South Australia in 1982.

Guy was awarded Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons in 2002

He did surgical training at St Vincents and Wagga Wagga Base Hospital from 1993 – 1995 and in 1996 undertook research on the role of Nitric Oxide in the development of neo-intimal hyperpasia at the Bernard O'Brien Institute of Microsurgery, supervised by Professor Wayne Morrison.

Guy was Surgical Registrar at the Alfred Hospital in Melbourne in 1997 and consultant plastic surgeon at Southern Health, Peninsular Health and a fellow in hand and micro surgery at the Royal Children's Hospital in Melbourne.

Guy was survived by his wife Meg and three children.
